# ‘LIC likely to move ₹1.8-lakh cr into shareholders fund’

STOCK BOOSTER. To shore up investors’ confidence, insurance major may use funds for dividend or bonus

Life Insurance Corp of India (LIC) is planning to transfer nearly ₹1.8-lakh crore from policy holders’ funds into a fund earmarked to pay dividends or issue bonus shares, two sources said on Friday, as the country’s largest insurer aims to shore up both its own net worth and investor confidence.

35% FALL

The State-owned insurer listed on stock exchanges in May, but its stock has since dropped more than 35 per cent, wiping off nearly ₹2.23-lakh crore in investor wealth. LIC is now looking at steps to revive its share



price, said a government official.

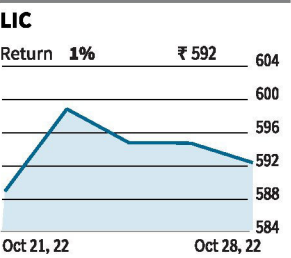
The company plans to transfer ₹1.8-lakh crore, a sixth of the ₹11.57-lakh crore, lying in its non-participating fund, to its shareholders’ fund, according to an official aware of the matter.

Life insurance companies primarily sell two types of

products: the first are ‘participating policies’ where profits are shared with customers and second are ‘non-participating,’ or ‘non-par,’ policies that have fixed returns.

LIC parks the premium it collects from the latter in a non-participating fund.

Transferring some of that into the shareholders’ fund



is one way to shore up investor confidence, as it would be an indicator of higher dividend payouts in the future, both the officials said.

TO BOOST NET WORTH

The surplus in the non-participating fund is earmarked for shareholders and can be transferred to shareholders

fund with approval from LIC’s board, which is yet to be sought, they said.

The transfer, if concluded, would boost LIC’s net worth by about 18 times from its current value of about ₹10,500 crore and top the net-worth chart among insurers, including SBI Life and HDFC Life, both the officials said.

LIC and Finance Ministry did not immediately respond to e-mails from Reuters seeking comment.

A bigger shareholder fund would draw the attention of new and existing investors as the amount would be used by LIC to transfer dividend or issue bonus shares in future, said Harvinder Singh, a partner at law firm DSK Legal.

## SEBI cuts face value for debt issues to ₹1 lakh

Markets regulator SEBI on Friday reduced the face value of debt security and non-convertible redeemable preference share issued on private placement basis to ₹1 lakh from the current ₹10 lakh. The move is to enhance liquidity in the corporate bond market, SEBI said.

The regulator said it has received representations from various market participants, including issuers, requesting for review of the denominations.

“In particular, non-institutional investors consider the high ticket size as a deterrent which restricts their ability to access the market for corporate bonds. If the face value and trading lot is reduced, more investors can participate which, in turn, will enhance the liquidity in



the corporate bond market,” it said.

The new guidelines will be applicable from January 1, 2023.

However, with respect to shelf placement memorandum which is valid as on January 1, 2023, the issuer thereof will have the option while raising funds through tranche placement memorandum to keep the face value at ₹10 lakh or ₹1 lakh, SEBI clarified.

## More for retail in future NHAI InvITs: Gadkari

Enthusied by the overwhelming retail investor response to the recent InvIT from NHAI, wherein NCDs worth ₹1,430 crore were issued, Union Highways Minister Nitin Gadkari said the retail portion will go up in new such fund-raising ahead.

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The minister was addressing a gathering at the BSE after listing the second tranche of the NHAI Infrastructure Investment Trust (InvIT) and NCD; the issue was oversubscribed nearly seven times.

As much as 25 per cent of the issue was reserved for re-

tail investors, but NHAI had not said how many times the retail portion was oversubscribed, instead saying it had an overwhelming response.

“We want more and more general public to invest in these InvITs, I mean in our roads, and I can assure you that NHAI’s roads offer 100

per cent security to investors and the best internal rate of return. So, going forward, we will have more portion being reserved for retail,” Gadkari said without quantifying any numbers.

MORE RETAIL QUOTA

NHAI chairperson Alka Upadhyaya also said the forthcoming InvITs from the NHAI will have more units reserved for retail but did not quantify.

Gadkari said the InvIT so far has raised over ₹8,000 crore from foreign and domestic institutional investors, but the second tranche was special given that 25 per cent of the NCD issue was reserved for retail investors.

## Global Health sets price band at ₹319-336, issue opens on Nov 3

Global Health Ltd, which operates and manages hospitals under the Medanta brand, said it has set a price band of ₹319-336 a share for its ₹2,206-crore initial public offering (IPO).

The IPO will open for public subscription during November 3-7. The bidding for anchor investors will open on November 2.

The IPO consists of a fresh issue of equity shares aggregating to ₹500 crore and an offer for sale (OFS) of up to 5.08 crore equity shares. As a part



of the OFS, Anant Investments, an affiliate of private equity major Carlyle Group, and Sunil Sachdeva (jointly with Suman Sachdeva) will of-flood equity shares.

Currently, Anant Invest-

ments holds a 25.64 per cent stake in Global Health and Sachdeva owns a 13.41 per cent stake in the company.

USE OF FUNDS

At the upper end of the price band, the company is expected to raise ₹2,206 crore. Proceeds from the fresh issue will be used to pay debt and for general corporate purposes.

Half of the issue size has been reserved for qualified institutional investors, 35 per cent for retail investors and the rest for non-institutional investors. Investors can bid for a minimum of 44 shares and in multiples thereof.

## WhatsApp chats: Regulators struggle to fix insider trading cases

Regulators across the globe are finding it difficult to fix insider-trading based on WhatsApp chats.

Recently, according to a Bloomberg report, the US Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) asked money managers for details on who at their firms oversees retention of electronic communications.

Under SEC rules, money managers face less expansive record-keeping rules than brokerages, with retention focussed on documents related to investment advice.

However, like banks, investment firms are required to monitor communications involving their business to head off improper conduct, said the Bloomberg report.

WHATSAPP LEAK

While SEC is trying to tighten the noose around insiders using WhatsApp texts, a similar exercise by the Securities and Exchange Board of India has hit the

wall. SEBI recently suffered a set-back in a WhatsApp leaks case.

The Supreme Court rejected SEBI’s appeal to penalise a senior employee of a Mumbai equity brokerage house for sharing stock-price sensitive data on WhatsApp on the grounds that the regulator went behind the secondary source of the leaked data and could not find the primary source of the message.

In 2017, SEBI found forecasts by several brokerages that seemed to have knowledge on price-sensitive information such as financial results ahead of official announcements from companies.

Following this, SEBI had conducted raids on 26 suspected entities and investigated nearly 190 phones of individuals at brokerages and found that the messages by them were a close approximation of actuals. SEBI suspected this to be an alleged insider trading and cracked the whip on them.

It imposed ₹15 lakh penalty against Neeraj Kumar Agarwal and Shruti Vora, then employees of Antique Stock Broking, for forwarding the messages.



SETBACK AT SAT

The individuals then moved Securities Appellate Tribunal (SAT), which, while dismissing the regulator order, said: SEBI failed “to prove any preponderance of probabilities that the impugned messages were unpublished price-sensitive information, that the appellants knew that it was unpublished price-sensitive information and with the said knowledge they or any of them had passed the said information to other parties”.

Accordingly, the tribunal set aside SEBI’s orders in the case.

SEBI then escalated the issue with Supreme Court, which also declined to entertain the regulator’s arguments, saying: “They are

secondary chain. They have just forwarded the messages. It would mean upsetting everything and putting the burden again on them, which we are not willing to do... On the facts and circumstances of the case, we find no reason to entertain the appeal.”

Following these verdicts, SEBI also on its own has disposed of similar cases that it was pursuing.

Does this set-back mean SEBI cannot not rely on WhatsApp and other electronic trails that can offer corroborative evidence to fix insider-trading? Though the SEBI approach was clear, it could not conclusively convince the higher judicial authorities with the data that it had collected.

Despite these set-backs, SEBI should actively pursue e-trails and as Supreme Court said, it should go after primary sources of such leaks which can be easily done in this advanced technological era.

For that, it has to strengthen its data analytics team which should work in tandem with other regulatory bodies, concerned authorities and India Inc to nab the culprits.

company reported an over four-fold increase in its Q2 consolidated net profit.

Crompton Greaves Consumer’s Q2-FY23 revenue grew 23 per cent y-o-y (+16 per cent 3-year CAGR and in line with JMF expectation) on a consolidated basis led by 12 per cent growth in the Appliances segment and consolidation of Butterfly (BGAL) post acquisition. However, the good show in appliances was more than offset by mid-single digit decline in fans (slow channel filling due to BEE rating change) and sustained pressure in pumps (flat y-o-y). The lighting segment continued to be plagued by falling conventional sales (-35 per cent y-o-y; 8-9 per cent of total lighting revenue) and flat growth in the B2C LED segment. With softening commodity prices, the management expects volume growth to bounce back sooner rather than later and expects margins to recover to historic levels. We cut our FY23-FY25 estimates by 13-18 per cent respectively to reflect Q2-FY23 performance.

Anupam Rasayan India’s Q2-FY23 EBITDA tad lower; on path to improve ROCE while revenue was a tad lower, GM and EBITDA margins were in line with Jefferies expectation and indicate margin resilience on the back of pass-through of raw material costs. PAT was, however, 16 per cent below our expectation due to elevated interest expenses on working capital debt and FX loss on foreign currency debt of ₹440 crore. Inventory days declined in H1-FY23, and the management guided to further reduction in H2. Fire incident at one of its facilities could need three months to restore production, impacting revenues to the tune of ₹30-40 crore. ARIL announced \$10 million over three-year new contract with a European innovator that has commenced production. QIP proceeds will fund growth over the next four years at nearly 2x asset turns. We have raised FY23 Ebitda 5 per cent on stable margins and forecast EBITDA/PAT CAGR of 24/27 per cent over FY22-25.
